Application period will be open from September 24, 2021 through October 8, 2021 at 4:00 PM. All applications must be returned by the deadline. Follow up contact will begin once the application period has ended.

ALL APPLICATIONS ARE KEPT IN A FILE UNTIL AFTER THE DEADLINE. AT WHICH TIME THEY ARE REVIEWED FOR CONSIDERATION. Please do not contact city hall in reference to your application. Failure to follow the hiring process can automatically disqualify you.

This is a salaried position with TCRS retirement and benefits package.

Qualifications

- Possess a valid motor vehicle operator's license
- Complete a criminal history disclosure form in a manner approved by the appointing authority and agree to release all records involving any criminal history to the appointing authority.
- Subject to an intense background investigation, which includes a check of State and Federal criminal records, driving history, education, military, service previous employment, and reference verification.
- Have no felony convictions.
- Have a High School Diploma or equivalent.

Requirements:

- Must be a P.O.S.T. certified officer in Tennessee, per TCA 38-8-106 or have qualifying certification from another state, per TCA 38-8-105.
- At least 10 years of progressive law enforcement experience with administrative experience and/or as a commanding officer i.e., Lieutenant, Captain, Assistant Chief is desired.
- Must pass a background check, medical/physical examination and psychological evaluation.
